Oktoberfest New York

The Watermark Bar turns Pier 15 in the South Street Seaport into a beer garden for three weekends (now through Oct. 2). Enjoy \$8 brats and pretzels washed down with \$8 Weihenstephan and Radeberger beers (1-liter steins are \$16) while drinking in views of the Brooklyn and Williamsburg bridges.

There will be live music and games like stein-holding contests and giant cornhole. Free general admission with online RSVP. Two-hour beer tasting events are \$60 from 3-5 p.m. 78 South St. See oktober-fest.nyc
